III. AGE

The minimum age is 18 years and the maximum age is 44 years. The minimum and maximum age shall be reckoned ad on 01-07-2017 with the following relaxations allowed for reckoning the maximum age limit as per rules.

- i. For S.Cs, S.Ts & BCs 5 (Five) years.
- ii. For Ex-service men 3 (Three) years in addition to the length of service in armed forces.
- iii. Disabled persons 10 (ten) years.
